## Expressions of Interest

Diving Australia's vision for excellence and sustainable success is based on a network of National Elite Development Centres (NEDC) and more recently a number of NTID programs. The NTID programs are part of the National Talent Identification Program which Diving Australia are currently operating in Queensland and Western Australia. Diving Australia is now establishing a NTID program in New South Wales and is seeking an experienced and motivated Coach for the New South Wales Squad in Sydney and invites qualified candidates to submit their expressions of interest for the position of NTID Coach – NSW Squad.

The primary objectives for the NTID Coach – NSW Squad will be to:

- Work closely with the National TID Coach to design and implement a daily training program for identified junior athletes selected in the National TID Program – New South Wales Squad in line with Diving Australia High Performance Program guidelines
- Provide a Daily Training Environment that will expose identified junior athletes to the physical and mental loads required to succeed at the international level
- Ensure technological advances and dry land equipment are used to enhance the quality of the daily training program
- Develop weekly, monthly and yearly training plans, evaluate and monitor athlete progress for identified athletes in the National TID Program – New South Wales Squad
- Implement a competition program for members of the National TID Program – New South Wales Squad incorporating state and national events for each squad athlete
